GENERAL DONATION AND CONTRIBUTION AGREEMENT

THIS CHRISTIAN COVENANT is entered into this ____ day of _____
between **Yucatan Peninsula Mission, Inc.** of Ouray, Colorado (hereinafter called "YPM") and

(hereinafter called "Donors").

RECITALS:

A. YPM is a non-profit Christian organization; it is organized in the State of Colorado, U.S.A. and serves individuals, families, communities and churches in the United States and Mexico.

B. YPM received a ruling dated May 8, 2002, effective January 22, 2001 from the Internal Revenue Service determining that it is exempt from U.S. Federal Income Tax under Section 501 (a) of the Internal Revenue Code as an organization described in Section 501 (c) (3), and further that donors may deduct contributions to YPM on their federal income tax returns under Section 170 of the Internal Revenue Code.

C. YPM financially supports Come and See Missions ministry programs that serve to better the lives of those in need in the Yucatan Peninsula and of the U.S.A., including:

(1) Labors of Love Program through communications and direction from regional Presbyteries, and invitations from local Congregations, we serve together to build churches, homes, schools, medical clinics and community centers or complete special mission projects.

(2) Field Education Program provides an approved seminary curriculum, Ordained Pastoral supervision and an encouraging congregation to an individual open to learn all that this unique part of the world can teach.

(3) The Medical Program is established as a ministry for outreach medical brigades to provide financial support and health care to people of

low-income families from cities, city suburbs, neighborhoods, as well as surrounding towns and small villages.

D. All of these ministries are maintained to nurture the growth of the human spirit in Christ: for those who visit and sponsor from the U.S. and for those who are benefited in the Yucatan.

NOW THEREFORE, the parties to this Agreement make the following commitments:

1. Donors' obligations. The Donors to this Agreement hereby make the following pledge for the benefit of YPM:

a. Beginning in _____ and continuing through _____, to pay _____00/100 (\$_____) U.S. Dollars per month to YPM to be used to further the mission of YPM through one or all of the above described ministries.

b. To consider, from time to time, appeals from YPM for additional support for extraordinary needs of the ministries, and/or the possibility of sponsoring/benefiting an individual in one of the programs.

c. To provide encouragement, care and nurturing in the form of correspondence and prayer for the ministry.

d. Upon the death, disability or default of either individual Donor, to honor as the remaining or surviving Donor, the entire obligations of this Agreement.

2. YPM Obligations. YPM hereby makes the following pledge for the benefit of Donors:

a. To receive and use Donors' monthly payments to benefit one or more of the YPM ministries as it in its sole discretion deems most appropriate.

b. To make reasonable and diligent efforts to maintain a safe, nurturing and Christian environment for all participants within the organization and its missions.

c. To properly notify Donors of any action taken by the IRS which affects the tax status of YPM as recited in paragraph B. above.

3. Mutual Obligations. The parties mutually agree as follows:

a. The payments to be made by Donors under this Agreement may be made less frequently than monthly provided any allowances are paid to YPM in advance of their due dates.
